A Tragedy is:

- When **The Main Character** in **The Story**
- Has A Fatal Flaw

Then, **During The Story:**

We **See The Fatal Flaw**of **The Main Character**And **This Fatal Flaw Leads To The Fall of The Main Character**

Sometimes, in The Tragedy, We May Even See:

The Main Character Go Into Ruin

So, As:

- Different Than A Comedy
- Like **Not So Happy**

A Tragedy is:

• Quite **Different Than A Comedy**

In A Tragedy, We Can See:

The Fatal Flaw of The Main Character in The Story Cause The Fall of The Main Character in The Story

A Note About Tragedy

The Main Character Would Be:

- Proceeding from Wrong
- A flawed bozo person
- Assigned as Staff

This Could Be The Type Of:

Leader Commander Boss Governor Master Dominant Figure

We See These Around, like:

• In **The Common**

About Proceed From Wrong

When We Were in School:

- We **Learned** That
- You Don't Proceed from Wrong

Whether it was:

On A Test or Common Behavior We Learned That You Don't Proceed from Wrong

Then, Proceeding from Wrong Was Told to Us:

Yet, We See Tragedy Main Characters:

- Proceeding from Wrong
- All of The Time
