Also:

- To share and chat
- And generally just feeling good!

The man likes to feel 'good,' when he can

He is a respectable man

About being respectable

The man does good at work

He:

- Pays attention
- Is considerate
- And he works well with other people

He does remember, that he is an accountant

He:

- Pays attention, so he is rather **smooth**
- And he is **careful** about things

With This:

Having some qualities
He is ok

In This Way:

He is a respectable man

Today

On this day:

- Today
- It is the man's day off

He doesn't go to his job today

He likes that it is:

- His day off
- He has some free time today

Also, it is a nice day outside!

Going for a walk

So:

• It is **nice** outside

The weather is good It is his day off And he has free time

Then the man:

• Plans to go for a walk

On his walk:

The man Intends to
See the town - his neighborhood
Get some exercise
And maybe think of something to do

There is always:

Something to do in his town

The man's plan

On his walk:

- The man may
- See a friend
- Notice a pretty thing or two
- Or even **find** a **good** time!

He 'possibly' might:

• Go and have lunch somewhere

There are some **ok Places** to **eat** in his **neighborhood!**

So the man:

- Plans to
- Go for a walk
- Maybe have **lunch**
- And perhaps
- Do some sightseeing too!

It looks like a good day for the man!

Starting out

After the man:

- Gets everything together at home
- He starts to go out for his walk

He usually walks
In the direction of downtown

It is not so far, to the downtown

As the man:

- Starts out
- He goes onto the street
- In front of his **house**

He begins to walk:

In the direction of the downtown

It is not so far, to the downtown

The nice day

So the man:

Walks along in his neighborhood

Seeing the **sights**Being **careful** of the **setting**, his **neighborhood**And **noticing** the **nice** day

He **notices** that:

- The sky is clear
- The weather is warm
- And, generally, that the people all look Ok

There are some people on the street,

But it is not **super** crowded

There is a **nice amount** of **people** on the **street!**

After two blocks of walking

As the man:

- Walks down the street
- Being careful along the way
- He gets to a main area

There:

In the main area He sees a few people on the street

Some of the **people** are **together** And **others** are **standing alone**

The girl

Among the **people** on the **street:**

- One of them is the girl
- She is standing alone, and he sees her

He thinks that:

She is looking rather pleasant

As he sees her:

- The man
- Thinks about approaching her, to say Hi

He thinks that she looks nice And that she looks friendly!

Meeting the girl

The man:

• Walks up to the girl

She sees him approaching her And she watches him come forward

He smiles at the girl, and then says hello!

If she **truly** is:

- Nice
- Then perhaps they might meet

He usually gets along well with people!

The girl seems to:

- Not **mind** him
- And so she says hi to him

The girl seems friendly:

He thinks And so he decides to Talk further

Asking the girl a question

The man:

- Tells the girl
- That she **seems** nice

He then says, also:

- That he has an Idea
- Even, An Offer, for her

He says that he will tell it to her Now

The girl **listens**

The Offer

The man Starts:

- To **Tell** the **girl** about
- The Offer

He **tells** her:

That He has A **Plan**

They could have An Event together

He says that:

- If she **comes** with **him**
- Then they could **Do** something

They could:

Go for a walk
A stroll down the street

Afterall, he says:

It is a **nice** day And it is **not** too **far**

Then:

- They could
- Have lunch together

Either, he knows of a place to eat

Or, they could choose a place together

He invites her:

So **he** would **pay** for the **lunch**

It would be his **Treat:**

To buy their lunch together!

Also Too

The man continues

Then:

- After the lunch together
- He could walk back with her

He says that:

Like this, then,
They will have had lunch together!

The girl thinking

The girl hears his Offer

She:

Sees him
Standing there
Looking 'clean'

The man is a professional man:

• He has **presented** his **Offer** to **her**

And so, she is 'thinking' to herself

The man thinking

The man:

- Sees her
- Standing there
- And 'thinking' to herself

He thinks to himself:

He asks himself Maybe he should say More

He has just told the girl:

• About The Offer

Go for a **walk** together Eat **lunch** together Then **walk back** after **lunch**

He doesn't know:

- If what he said
- Is enough

He doesn't know:

If **The Offer** Alone Is **enough**

Is:

The Offer Alone
Enough for her
To go with him
For the lunch together

What the man is thinking

The man sees that:

- The girl is nice
- Friendly
- And that it is a nice day outside

He has presented:

• The Offer to her

They could have lunch together

He **thinks** that:

It is a **good** idea for **her** To **accept The Offer**

He thinks that:

They should go And have lunch together!

She should accept The Offer

The man:

- Thinks that
- She should
- Accept The Offer

He sees the girl:

Still thinking to herself

He really wants her:

To accept The Offer

So he **decides** to:

• Try a little 'more'

He wants to:

Add 'more' to The Offer

Maybe that will help her to accept it!

The man deciding

He sees that:

• The girl is not yet decided

He **thinks** that:

He **still** has a **chance** To **win** a **date** with **her**

Also:

It is a nice day outside!

He thinks that they can still:

- Go for a walk
- Have lunch together
- And then **return**
- Along the same way that they went!

He adds more to The Offer

The man does want:

- For the girl to
- Accept The Offer

He wants her:

To go and have lunch with him!

So he **decides** to:

• Add a little 'more'

He will add more:

To what he said

Maybe he could just add a little more:

To 'clarify' what he said in The Offer

Maybe it would show:

• His sincerity

Maybe it would:

Give her more chance To see his nice Offer

The Offer:

Them having lunch together!

Adding more:

So the man adds 'more'

He says to her:

'You know, these things that I say,

You can count on from me'

Waiting for a reply

The girl hears him, what he said

She:

Continues to think to herself

She also **thinks** of:

• The Second thing that he said

He said to her:

'You know, these things that I say,

You can count on from me'

Reviewing the Conversation

So:

- We Have
- The Conversation
- The Man and The Woman Story

We see:

The 'meeting' of these two people

When we:

- Look at this 'meeting'
- We see that there are 3 Steps here:

The man is seeing the girl Simple, pretty and nice

He is approaching the girl to talk

And then he makes The Offer to her!

The man does want:

- For the girl to
- Accept The Offer

Looking at the First Offer

At First:

- The man
- Approaches the girl
- After seeing her

He sees that:

She is Simple, pretty and nice

He probably thinks:

That it is ok
It is safe
Even a 'good' idea
To make The Offer to her

This was the First Offer:

• That he **made**

This seems fine:

To 'like' her enough
To make The Offer

The man waiting for reply

Then, after he makes his Offer:

- He waits and watches
- For the girl's **reply** or **reaction**

He notices:

That the girl
Doesn't reply 'soon' to The Offer

She:

Pauses
Thinking about what he said

It starts to get interesting:

When the man
Thinks again
About the girl's reply

He seems to:

Double checkOn what he **did**He **made The Offer**

Adding A Second Measure to his Offer

This is:

- The Main Part of the Story:
- The Man and The Woman

After the girl:

- Pauses, thinking about what he said
- The man **decides** to
- Add 'more' to The Offer

He added the line:

You know, these things that I say,

You can count on from me'

When he added this line:

- To The Offer
- We call this:
- Adding A Second Measure

He added one 'more' Measure to The Offer

This made The Offer:

Bigger, and maybe 'better'

About Adding The Second Measure

We see that the man:

• Added A Second Measure to The Offer

He did this after:

Watching for the girl's reply or reaction

She was:

Thinking about **The Offer** As **it** was **said** to her

So he **did** this:

• Adding A Second Measure to his Offer

With:

Adding A Second Measure
The man shows that

He probably cares about his Offer And maybe the girl too

He seems to think that:

• His Offer is Good

Good Valid Even timely

Afterall:

It is a nice day outside!

He might **think** that:

The Offer is 'called' for Like, the 'right' thing!

Thinking about the girl

When the girl:

- Hears the man at first
- When he makes The Offer
- She listens

She:

Allows him to speak to her

Then:

- She Sees him add
- The Second Measure to The Offer

You know, these things that I say,

You can count on from me'

She probably likes it

She probably thinks:

That **The Offer**Is more 'real,' even solid!

The man extends himself

So the man:

• Makes his Second Measure

Не:

Adds the additional line To clarify Tr reassure the girl

So she:

- Sees
- That the man 'extends' ' himself

He **seems** like **he** is:

Caring

And he seems:

To want his Offer to continue

So she:

- Sees
- That the man 'extends' ' himself

Considering the girl

We see:

- That he 'invests' himself
- In the **conversation**

The man:

Considers the girl

And then **he:**

Chooses to add
The Second Measure to his Offer

By **doing** this:

- Adding The Second Measure
- To The Offer
- He tries to 'reassure' the girl

He wants her:

To **think** that His **Offer** is **'good**

good valid even **timely!**

Remember that:

He is a 'professional' man

So he hopes:

That, with the **girl**, He does **'good'** work!

Going the Second Measure

When the man:

- Adds the Second Measure
- Having thought about it beforehand
- He shows that he
- Believes in what he is doing

He is putting 'more' of him in 'there'

Being in A Place

So, by:

- Being there, with the girl
- And adding the Second Measure
- To The Offer
- This can be 'reassuring' for the girl!

The **Point** to **this** is:

- After making the Second Measure
- To the Offer
- The man 'implies' to the girl
- That **he** is in **A Place**

The **Place** would **be**:

The Place of issuing his Offer!

The man looking Solid

The man:

- Tries to convince the girl
- The Offer

When he:

Adds the Second Measure
To his Offer
He shows that he Believes

The man:

Believes in what he is doing

He:

Invests himself
In the meeting with the girl
He puts more of 'himself' in there

So, he is:

- Believing in his Offer
- He is wanting The Offer
- To continue
- To go forward

And, by doing this:

He is more there More 'present' in the meeting

After adding:

The Second Measure, There is 'more' of him For the girl to get to know!

This can be called:

• Being more 'solid'

Trying to convince the girl

So the man:

- Tries to convince the girl
- The Offer

Не:

Tries to convince the girl
By doing this:
Adding the Second Measure
To the Offer

He is:

Coming forward

He is:

Extending himself

Then:

- It is easier for her
- To find him 'convincing'

If this is 'so'
If it is 'good'
Then she has met
A good man!

And he is trying:

To 'convince' her of that!

Helping ourselves to look better

So:

- By adding the Second Measure
- To his **Offer**
- The man looks more solid

He looks better, after adding 'more'

With the **Second Measure**:

As additional

Then there is 'more' there!

And this is what the man:

- Wants to do
- What he **tries** to **do**
- In order to win the girl's attention

If she likes him, then

They can have this event together!

They can 'do' The Offer!

Summary

So here we have seen:

- The 'good' Story:
- The Man and The Woman

They had a simple 'meeting,' these two

It was:

- Only their first encounter
- Yet there are some **fun things**
- To take away with it

The man:

Made the Offer at the start

Then, later:

He added the Second Measure of The Offer

So he did **commit** himself

He **committed** himself:

- When he
- Came forward
- And showed his regard for the girl

He committed himself, also:

- When he
- Decided to add
- The Second Measure of The Offer

This showed:

That he was caring and thoughtful

So:

This can make The Offer 'fuller'

This is because:

He put 'more' of himself in it!

The man was 'more'

When he added

The Second Measure of The Offer

Looking Attractive

When **The Offer** was:

- Made by the man
- It was 'simple'

The Offer was just an 'invitation' to lunch

And then:

- When the girl saw
- That there were **two parts** to
- The Offer
- It was more likely that she
- Could find the Offer 'attractive'

If she:

Found it 'attractive
Then it would be
A 'good' Offer, like 'positive'

So:

- There was a 'value' for the man
- If he could make The Offer
- Look 'attractive'

If they both:

Liked The Offer
From him for her
Then they could be
On The 'same' page
In touch with each other

This way, they likely could:

• Attend the 'event' together

The two of them, going for a walk

And then, having lunch together

Having a Place

We have seen:

- That the man's **Offer**
- And the Second Measure to The Offer
- Made the whole thing 'attractive'

I also **mentioned** that:

By adding the Second Measure To The Offer The man was more 'full'

The man was even 'bigger:'

After he made the full Offer

The Offer had two parts in it

So the man:

- Had more 'substance'
- After he added
- The Second Measure to The Offer

This makes him look like:

He has a 'place'

The 'place' is:

Where the full Offer

Was **made** from

Using A Place as A Seat

Having a 'place' is 'good'

And:

The man had a 'place' When he added 'more'

He added 'more:'

To The Offer

After that:

• He was 'more'

More solid More full More with substance

Then:

- The 'place' that he had made
- Served like a 'seat' for him

With a 'seat' then he could:

- Work better
- Be more stable
- And 'appear' better
- To the **people** around **him**

What the girl saw

So, with The Offer:

- Having the **two parts**
- Then there was 'more' there
- For the girl to 'see'

The **Original Offer**And the **added part**To go with it

There was 'more' there

For the girl to 'see'

This way, the girl:

- Got to 'see' that
- The man seemed to care
- And he stayed
- To show it too!

And this is a lot 'more'

And much 'better' than

Just a 'simple' Offer alone

Without:

- Adding The Second Measure
- To The Offer
- Then the girl **might not**
- Understand as much!

I **think** that:

It **helped** the **man**

When he 'bolstered' The Offer

With 'more'

It gave The Offer a 'boost'

Yay
