*A **Star** in The **Sky***

***Continuing Along**
Seeming ok
Perhaps
Even **Attractive**
Or
Even **Pretty***

*She Would
Continue Along
With **Me**
At **Work**
Like
A **Star** in The **Sky***

Near The End:

Of A **Project**
She Would
Balk
Hesitate or Stall

This Was **Like**:

- **Reticent**

When I Saw This:

I **Thought**
Hey
When A **Project**
Concludes
We Don't **Hesitate**

We **Don't**:

Drop The Ball

On A **Project**:

- We **See** it
- Along The **Way**
- **Progressing**

And **then**:

- We **See** it
- **Arriving** At The **Finish**

So:

At The **Finish**
Of A **Project**
We
Take it in
Deliver it
Complete it

There **is**:

Almost No **Choice**
At The **End**
Of A **Project**

We **Finish It**
